Rather than using a collage of fabric pieces, you will discover how to take readily available paper that you have-to-hand, to inspire a one-of-a-kind quilt for your home.

## **About Sarah**

Sarah likes to find inspiration in everyday objects to create fun paper art using recyclable materials from wrappers, pages from magazines, and even canned food labels. She uses these collages for initial design to springboard to a full-sized fabric quilt.

Sarah loves the combination of old and new; of the traditional and contemporary; patterns passed down through the generations and her personal contribution bringing something new. There is also a book in the pipeline due to be published shortly called "Collage to Quilt". It is the first craft book of its kind, combining the disciplines of paper collage and quilting.
